- Doug mentioned a few projects that we have been milling around the church.
 - One project was new carpeting in the parish hall/narthex.
 - Natural Light in the parish hall.
 - Updating the kitchen cabinets.
 - Window in the naïve
 - Sidewalk and patio at the rectory
 - Linda would like to see the project be something done around the church, not the rectory.
- Jane and Doug have been gathering estimates on some of these projects.
 - Mostly in carpeting
- Doug suggests to narrow down what we want to do before making a decision.
- Choir Robes money and improvements money will be coming out of separate funds.
- Sharon will get quotes on replacing cabinets in the kitchen.
- Linda proposed to table the decision on these projects until the September meeting.
- Robes are 30+ years old
 - \circ $\,$ We have money from memorial gifts from members who were in the choir to be used.
- Choir Alb has been picked as the best fit for us
 - \$120 a piece, crosses are roughly \$10 a piece as well.
 - We would get 15% off if we order 10 or more robes
 - We are looking at 20+ robes to buy in various sizes.
 - Some families open to contributing.
- Story Corps Project
 - One of Linda's projects she is wanting to do.
 - She will be grabbing and interviewing random people at the church to tell their story and their journey at St. James.
 - $\circ~$ She will be asking the vestry to listen to help brain storm ab out a new mission statement.
- <u>Stewardship</u>

- Alex has volunteered to be stewardship chair this year and has asked to have a co-chair to take over as the chair the next year and carry on this tradition.
 - Proposed date is November 12
 - Eric will think about being co-chair.
